WHEREAS, the City of Albany has a diverse Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, Asexual, and Ally (LGBTQIA+) community and is committed to supporting visibility, dignity and equity for all people in the community; and

WHEREAS, June has become a symbolic month in which the LGBTQIA+ community and supporters come together in various celebrations of pride; and

WHEREAS, Albany is joining other cities across the United States recognize and celebrate June as LGBTQIA+ Pride Month; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany recognizes and appreciates both the Albany High School Gender and Sexuality Alliance Club, a place where queer students have a safe space to come together and have fun and Albany's Pride, an LGBTQIA+ Advocacy group for Albany Unified School District for their ongoing work to ensure a positive environment for LGBTQIA+ students and parents.
