4	AND STROLL-ISH EVENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000 AND THE
5	TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES FOR THE 2025 SOLANO STROLL
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7	WHEREAS, the City Council received a request from the Solano Avenue Association
8	(SAA) for sponsorship of the 2025 Solano Stroll and Stroll-ish events; and
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10	WHEREAS, the Council has expressed support for these community events as a way to
11	support local businesses and further community engagement within the City; and
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13	WHEREAS, the City received a total of \$4,711,702 in one-time American Rescue Plan
14	Act (ARPA) funding to help support recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic, and the City
15	Council authorized a total of \$1,657,143 of said funds on October 3, 2022 under Resolution
16	No. 2022-104 for business assistance programs to generally include business related events
17	and marketing, grants to assist businesses, and business promotion programs; and
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19	WHEREAS, the Council has directed that a total financial contribution of \$40,000 be
20	funded from the American Rescue Plan Act funds, with \$25,000 to be utilized for the Solano
21	Stroll and \$15,000 to be used for the Stroll-ish events; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 21101 requires the City to approve by
24	resolution the temporary closure of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events,
25	and other purposes when the closing is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who
26	are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing.
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1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby
2	authorizes a financial sponsorship for the SAA 2025 Solano Stroll and Stroll-ish events in the
3	amount of \$40,000 and the temporary street closures for the 2025 Solano Stroll; and
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5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the SAA shall be responsible for obtaining an
6	encroachment permit in advance of the events, when necessary, as well as the provision of
7	highly visible and accessible bicycle parking services, and other event-related needs including
8	but not limited to waste collection and diversion services including recycling and organics,
9	public signage, and event staffing.
