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WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 2026-31 on June 15, 2026, the City Council has called and given notice of a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026 in the City of Albany, County of Alameda, for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council for a full term of four (4) years, three (3) Members of the Board of Education for a full term of four (4) years, and one (1) Member of the Board of Education for a “short term” of two (2) years at said General Municipal Election using proportional ranked choice voting at large; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date, and that within the City the precincts, polling places, vote centers, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Alameda County Registrar of Voters canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election, and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY,
CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council for a full term of four (4) years, three (3) Members of the Board of Education for a full term of four (4) years, and one (1) Member of the Board of Education

1 for a "short term" of two (2) years using proportional ranked choice voting at large in
2 accordance with Measure BB approved by voters in 2020 (Chapter VII of the Albany
3 Municipal Code).

4
5 SECTION 2. That the Alameda County Registrar of Voters is authorized to canvass
6 the returns of the General Municipal Election for the City of Albany. The election shall be
7 held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.
8 Pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10403 and 10418, the election will be held and conducted
9 in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the Statewide General Election.

10
11 SECTION 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda is requested to
12 issue instructions to the Alameda County Registrar of Voters to take any and all steps necessary
13 for the holding of the consolidated election.

14
15 SECTION 4. That the City of Albany recognizes that additional costs will be incurred
16 by the County of Alameda by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County
17 of Alameda for any costs upon presentation of reasonably detailed invoices.

18
19 SECTION 5. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward without delay a certified
20 copy of this resolution to both the Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda and the
21 Alameda County Registrar of Voters.

22
23 SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
24 Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
