

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE ALBANY ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2026, the City’s Transportation Commission recommended approval of the Active Transportation Plan to the City Council; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the City has completed state-mandated environmental review
2 procedures and determined the plan is not a project under the California Environmental
3 Quality Act.

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5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby adopts the
6 Albany Active Transportation Plan.

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8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council finds that adoption of the
9 Albany Active Transportation Plan is not a project under the California Environmental Quality
10 Act (CEQA) pursuant to, without limitation, each on a separate and independent basis, CEQA
11 Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), Review for Exemption; Section 15004, Time of Preparation
12 related to the proposed action not authorizing potential uses as “projects” as defined under
13 CEQA; and Section 15262 related to the adoption of feasibility, planning studies, and policy
14 documents for possible future actions.
