Berkeley Food and Housing Project Narrative Report to City Council
April 2021 – June 2021

Activities To-Date

The Albany Project Hope team continues to be available for outreach efforts when called by Albany PD, the Albany CARES team, and during regularly scheduled outreach shifts. Great care is taken when engaging with unhoused individuals who often require multiple outreach attempts to build rapport and trust. Our Housing Navigator continues to conduct weekly, daily high-need clients home visits to ensure clients receive needed support adjusting to new housing units. These home visits include checking if clients have adequate food, maintaining a level of cleanliness of the team, and not hoarding. Encourage clients to participate in essential self-care and hygiene routines, abide by the landlord and rental agreement rules, and practice other life skills needed for successful housing stability, including money management. Problem-solving and mediation between recently housed clients and their landlords are provided to ensure clients can maintain housing and to retain relationships with landlords who, in return, will continue to partner with us in housing clients in the future.

This quarter, the Housing Navigator facilitated the move of four clients into the Albany transitional house, one client into an affordable housing unit, and another well-known client into temporary stay at a County funded motel while awaiting a PSH match. Eight clients received assistance with obtaining and completing required documents for PSH matches, and three received support with completing new applications for housing. Transportation has been essential in assisting clients in securing and maintaining permanent housing, including transport and help to view new units, transport to grocery stores, medical appointments, and shelter. We also assisted a well-known client with receiving essential clothing items and other support by reaching out and communicating with the client's friends and family.

Outreach engagement focused on clients residing in motels to move to more sustainable housing stays and relationship maintenance with landlords and other partners. The team supported eleven clients with rental assistance this quarter; however, three obtained either housing vouchers or moved to an affordable unit in May and no longer receive rental service. Six additional clients are expected to have vouchers cover rental costs in the next reporting period. Discussions surrounding cost-share for current units and other permanent housing options continue to ensure all clients have housing stability once our services end. Staff have continued to support clients by providing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), such as gloves and masks, and demonstrating the proper use of PPE. This quarter included thirty-eight total clients enrolled in Housing Navigation, one of whom received outreach services only.

Successes

This quarter, the Albany Project HOPE team has had several permanent housing matches and progress with a well-known, chronically homeless client. Eight clients received PSH matches, and one client successfully modified a section 8 voucher with the Housing Authority of

Alameda County from a one-bedroom to a two-bedroom to allow a caregiver, an Albany Project HOPE client, to be added to the household. This change will allow two clients to be housed on a single voucher and helping a client who would have otherwise been unable to obtain subsidized housing. All while ensuring the other client has the essential support and care needed for housing stability. One client moved into an affordable housing unit. Two successfully transitioned in place (in rapid rehousing teams), one using a voucher from the Oakland Housing Authority, the other utilizing a Shelter + Care voucher with the City of Berkeley.

Four clients successfully moved into the Albany transitional house and began working on documents and completing assessments needed for PSH. Additionally, staff successfully advocated for a well-known, chronically homeless client to receive a COACH voucher that would allow the client to utilize the voucher in Albany, where this client is well known, frequents daily, and expressed where he wants to be. The same client was matched with a project-based voucher located in The City of Fremont. However, staff understood this client would not accept that location and worked with Home Stretch staff to ensure the COACH voucher would be available for this client instead. Through coordination with other County programs, the team successfully secured temporary shelter (initially a motel stay then trailer) for this client while awaiting move-in to a permanent housing unit. This resource was vital to ensuring staff could keep regular communication with the client while transitioning to housing.

Challenges

This quarter has brought new and unexpected challenges both with staffing, funding, and client support. In April, we lost our supervisory case manager. At the same time, our use of HRC Flex Funding for motel stays came to a halt. This funding change forced us to move seven clients out of motel rooms. Our team offered shelter stays for each of these clients and continued to work with them on permanent housing options. Additionally, we realized that our success at moving clients into motels and rapid rehousing units during the height of the pandemic (quarter one and two) also drained a large portion of funding. The funding concern has placed us in a predicament of not continuing rental assistance at the same rate we had done previously.

Additionally, many of our clients' severe mental health disabilities make essential communication and coordination of services challenging for our team. Concerns with clients' responsiveness to phone calls, requests to meet, and their cooperation with obtaining required documentation such as accurate income statements have all posed a challenge to securing housing units after a PSH match is received. Additional challenges include some clients refusing shelter options while awaiting permanent housing while others who have a temporary shelter stay choose to return to familiar locations in the community due to mental health disabilities, creating concern among the community. Some clients receive multiple PSH matches while others have yet to receive one, making it challenging to find housing support for those clients and, in return, discouraging them. Regular mental health assistance is needed to help some clients be successful in the search for obtaining and sustaining permanent housing.

Client Satisfaction Surveys

Twenty-eight clients completed the satisfaction surveys, comprised of twenty-two multiple-choice questions. The questions allowed clients to respond to accessing services, inclusiveness of decision making in their care, support and communications from staff, and their overall feeling of how the program has affected their stability. The survey recorded responses using a five-point scale with possible options ranging from strongly agree to disagree strongly. Overall, clients reported they either strongly agreed or agreed that they like the organization, feel like they have a say in their services, feel comfortable asking questions, and feel they are coping despite challenges and problems. Below are pivot tables detailing additional client survey responses.

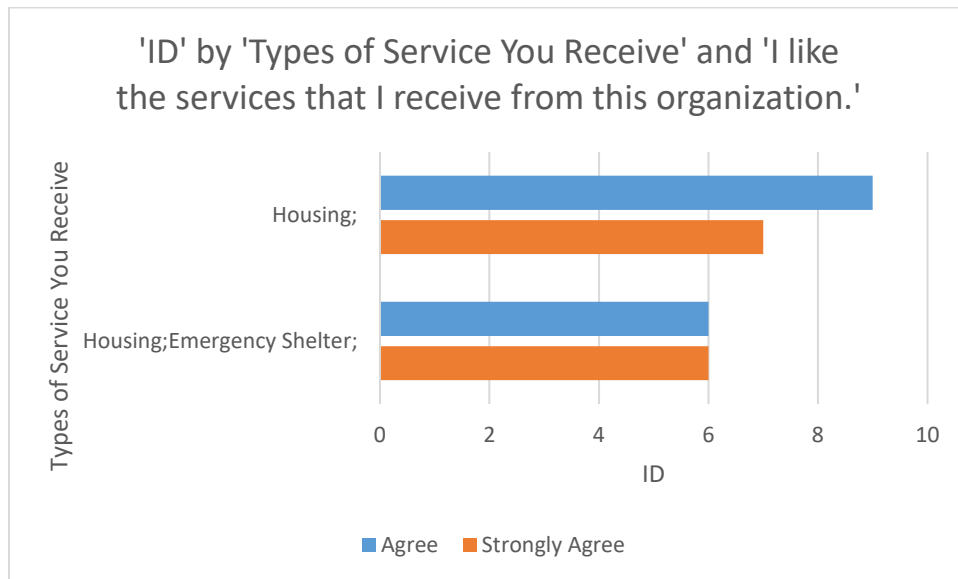

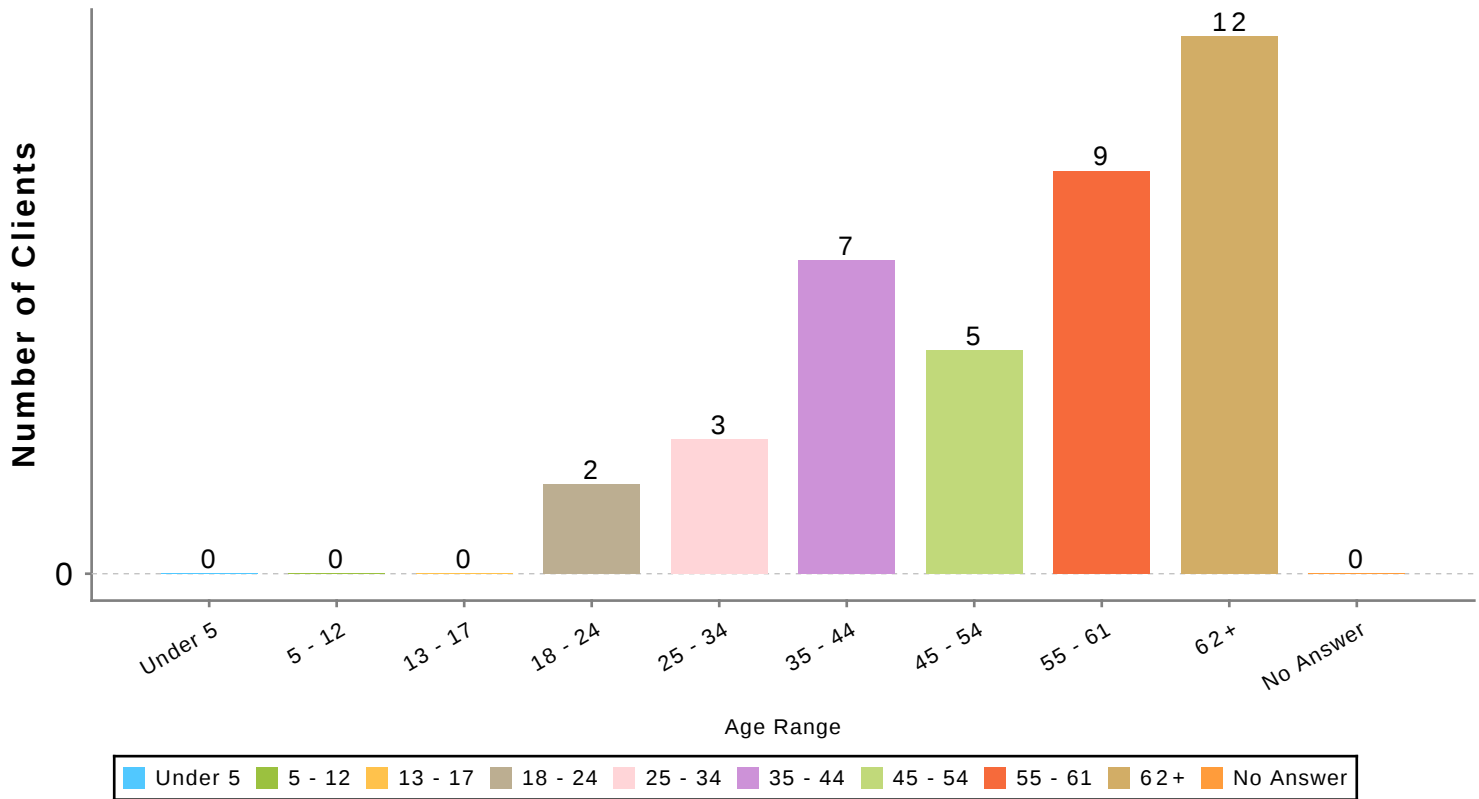

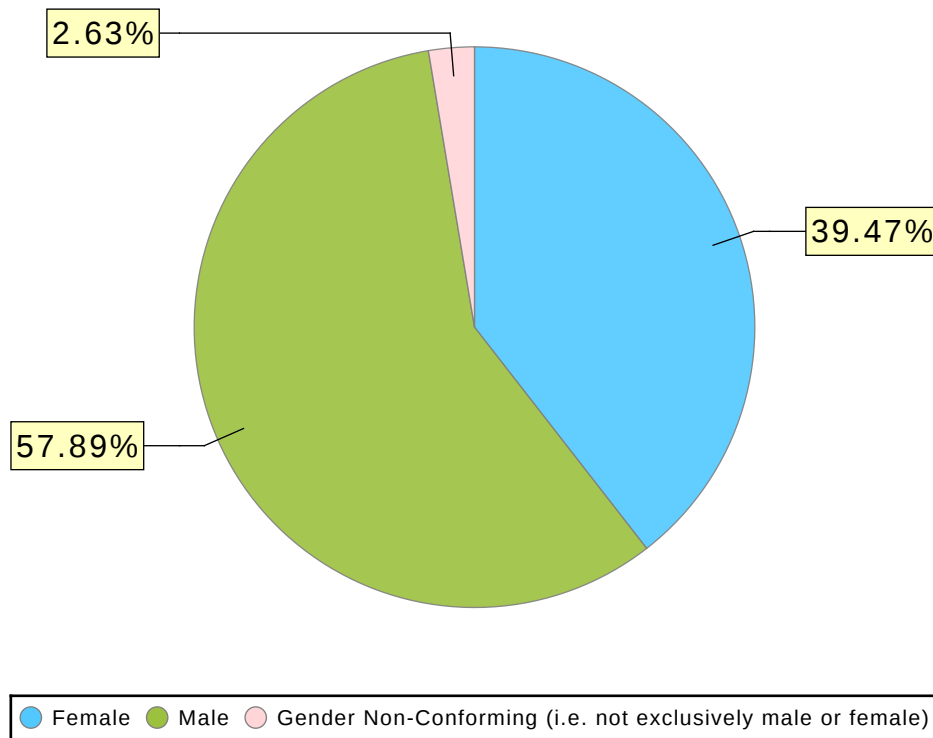

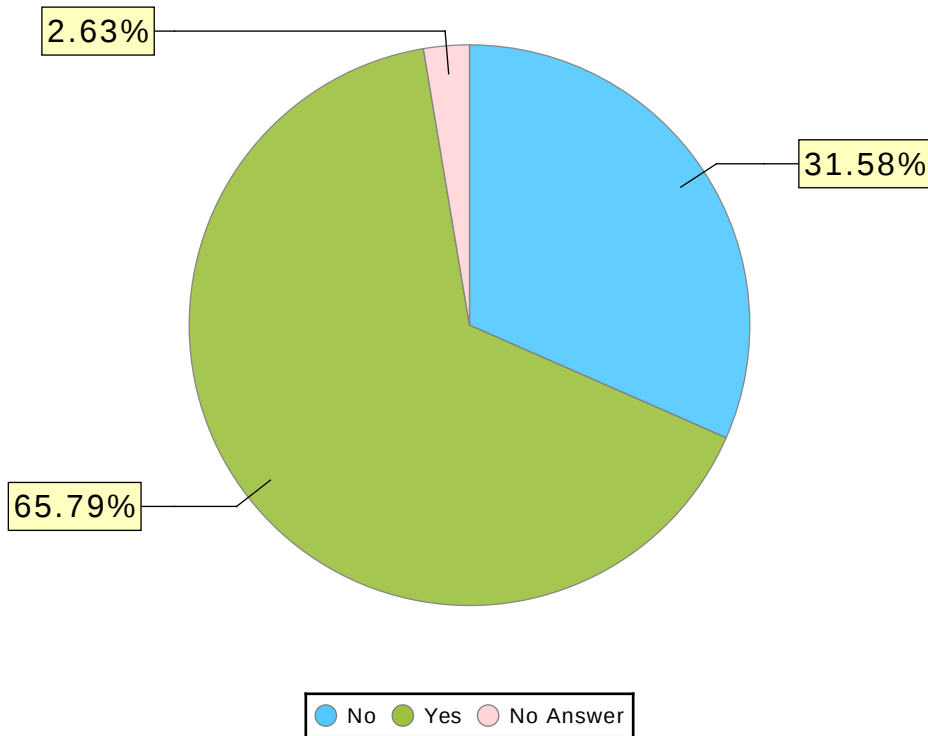
Race Chart

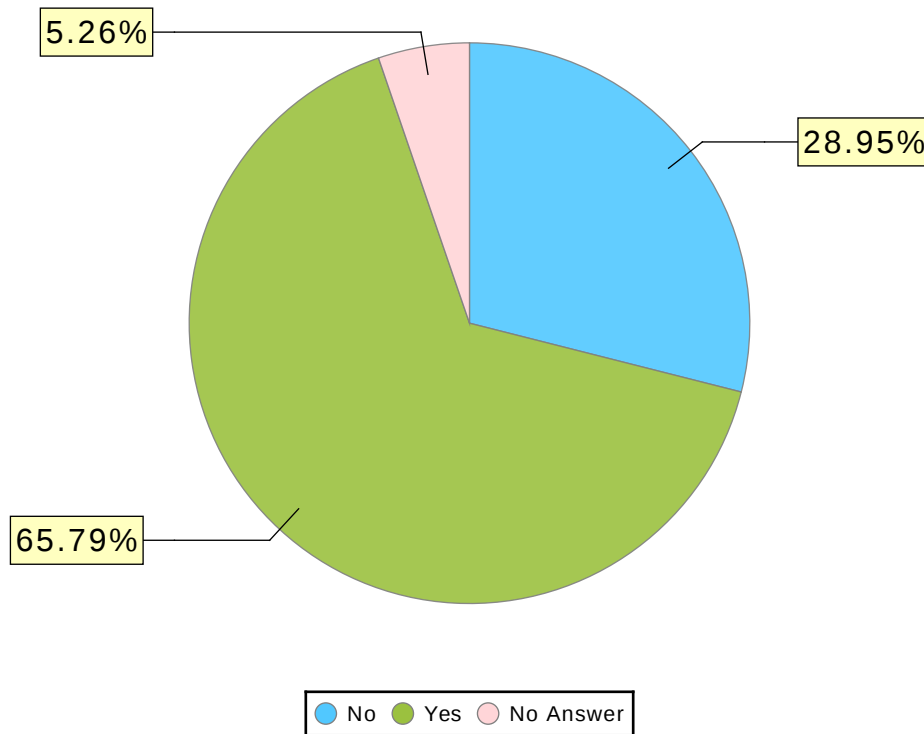

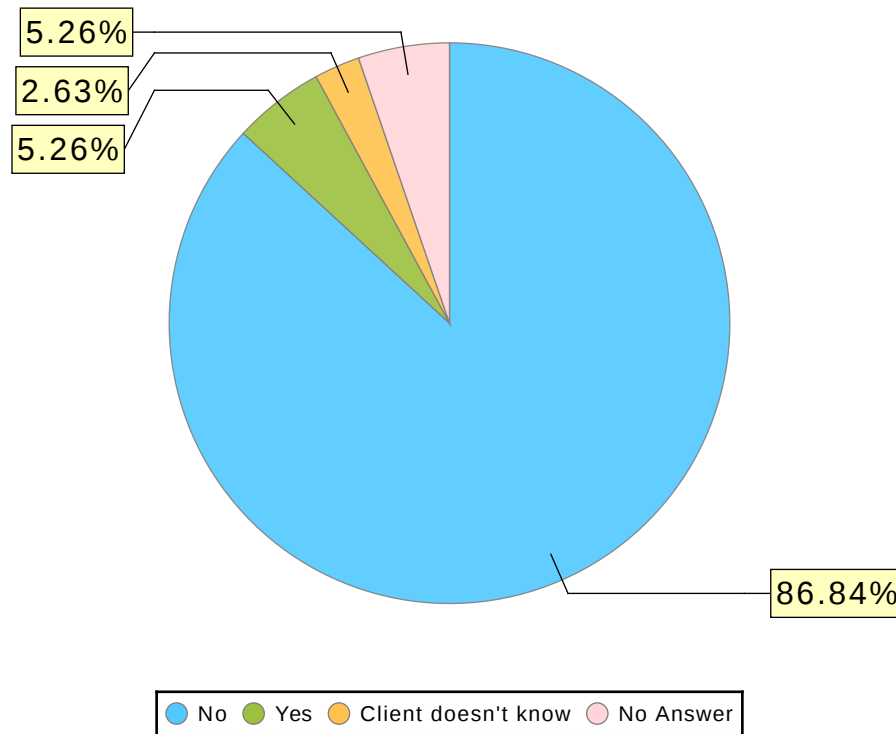

HIV/AIDS Chart



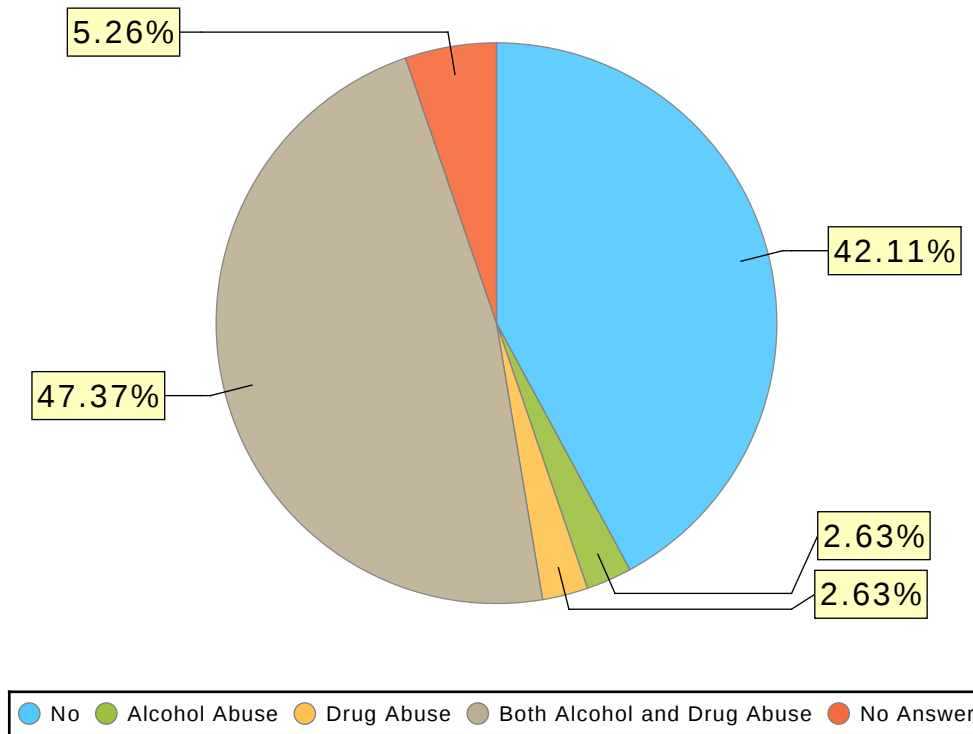

Mental Health Problem Chart



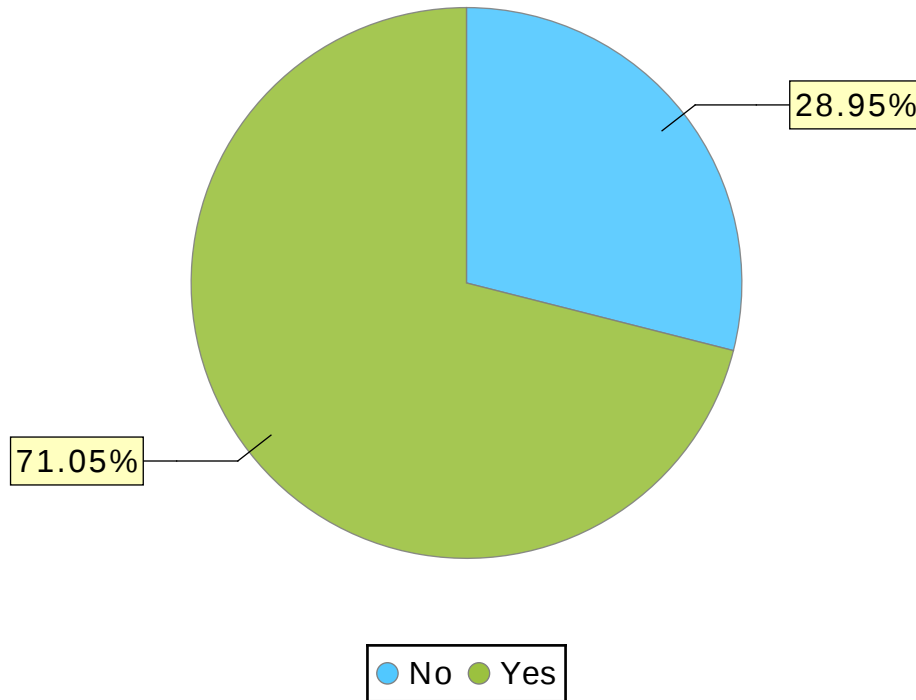

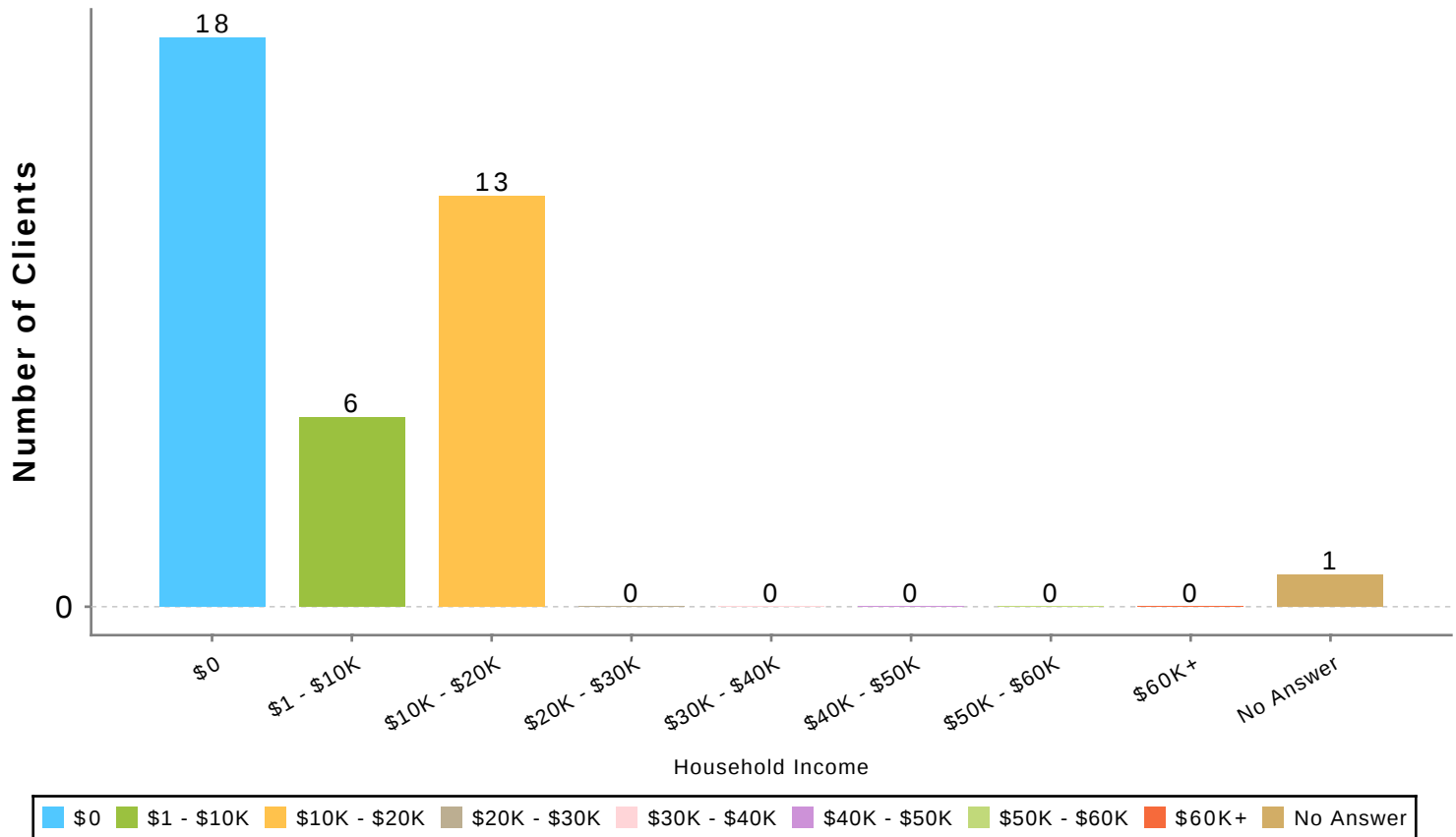

Physical Disability Chart



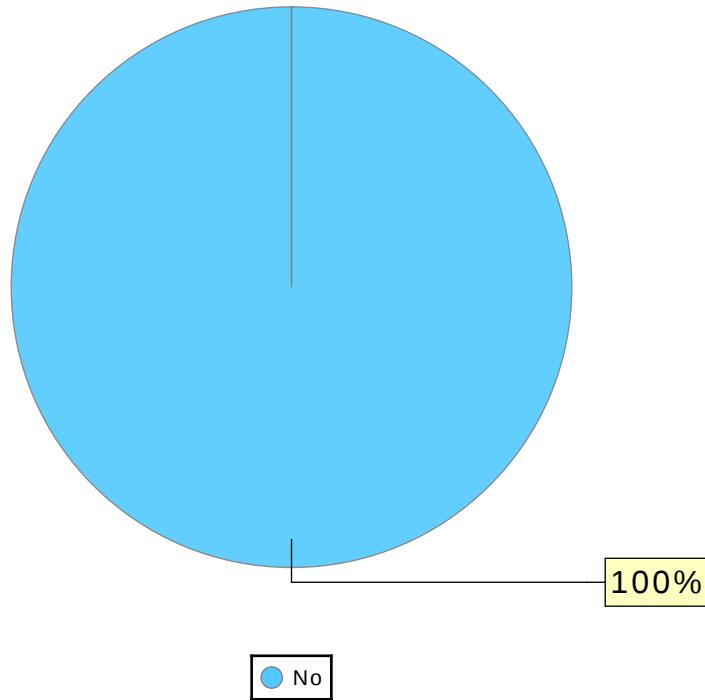

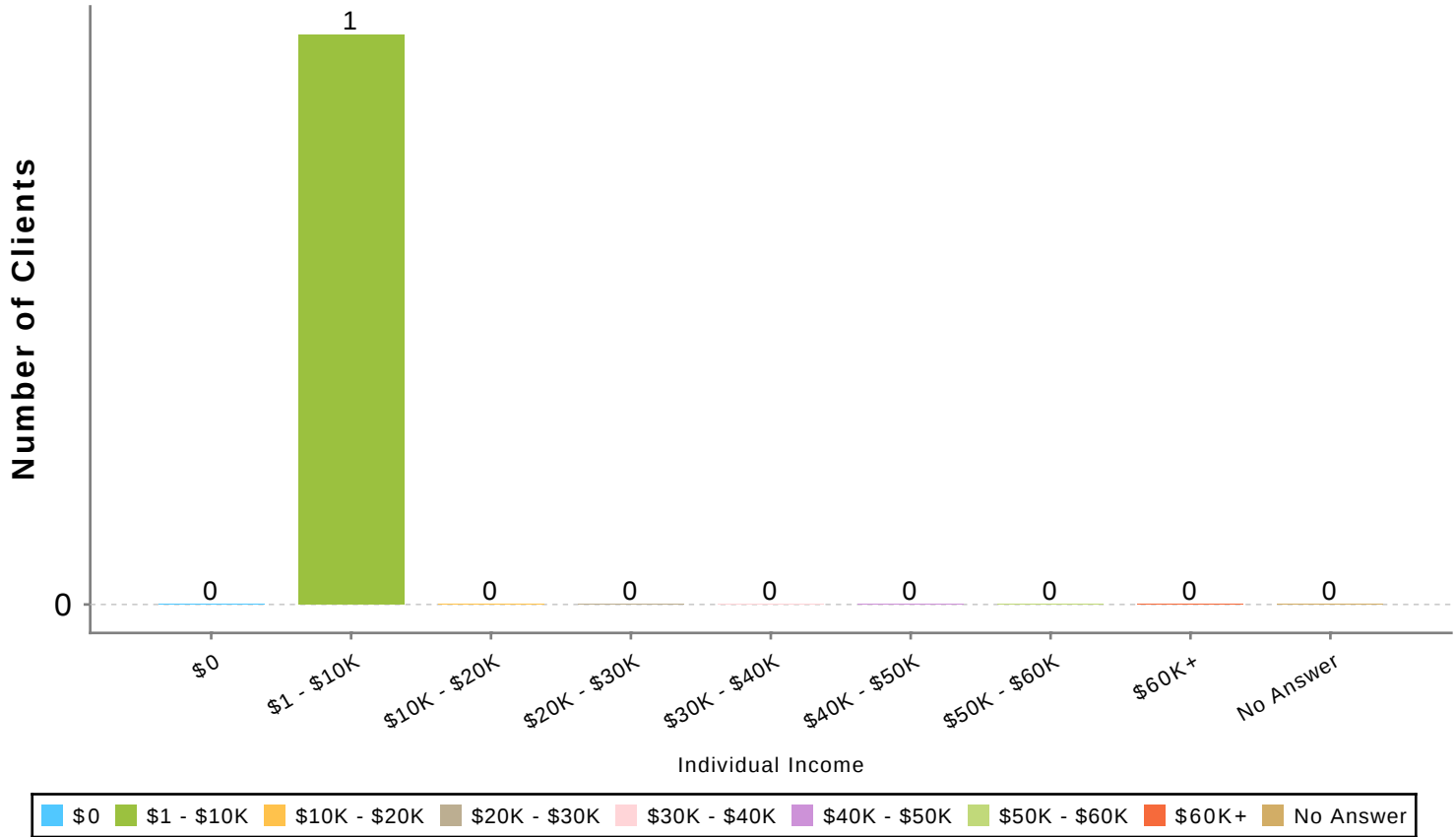

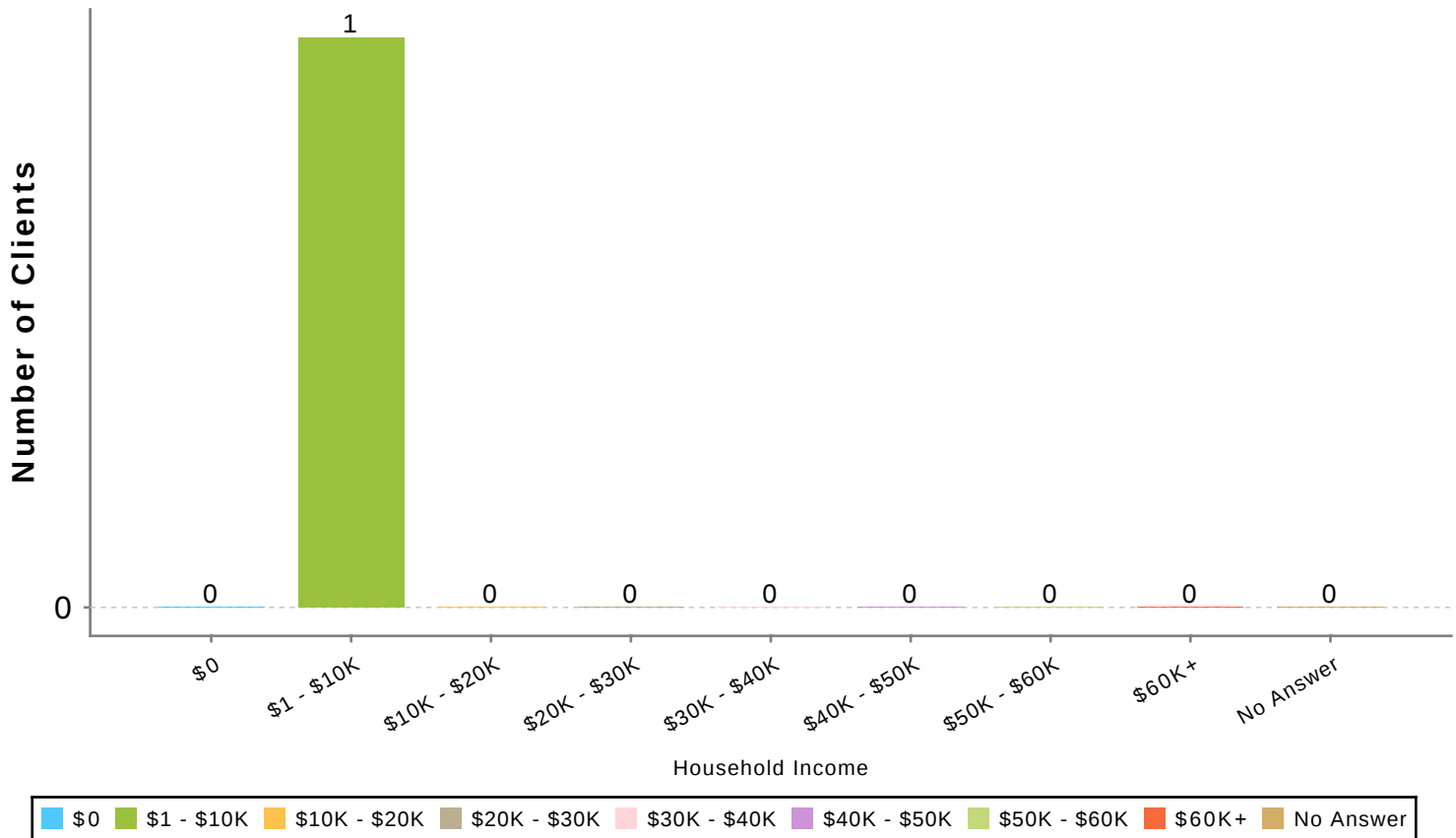

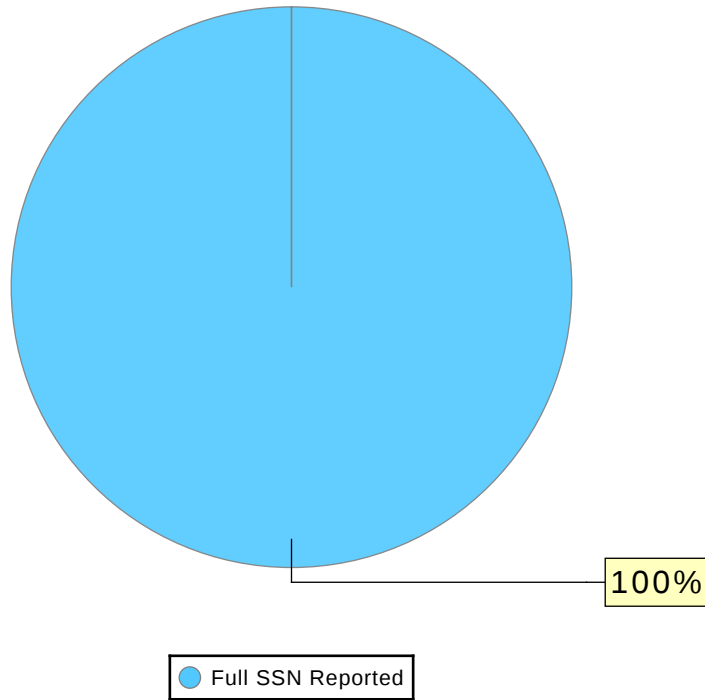
