10 Section 2: Section 5-2.2 entitled "Amount of Tax Generally", paragraph four, is amended

11 to read as follows:

12 A company, person, or utility, *not otherwise covered by this Chapter*,

13 providing a service similar to those services performed by a franchisee,

14 contractor, or utility ~~described in subsection 5-1.26~~ shall pay as a license tax

15 *at least* the same fees as the utility, franchisee, or contractor is paying under

16 any already existing agreement with the City.

17 Section 3: Section 5-2.2 entitled "Amount of Tax Generally", APPENDIX V-A (Business

18 License Tax List) is amended to read as follows:

Business	Tax	Term
<i>A person, business, company, entity, or any other form of business organization carrying on, conducting, managing or engaging in the business of providing utility service.</i>	<i>\$1.00 per \$1,000 of gross receipts</i>	<i>Annual</i>

19 *For the purpose of this classification, "utility service" shall include all forms of telephone service (including cellular), telegraph, gas and electric service.*

20 Section 4: Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of

21 this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not

22 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, and each

23 section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact

24 that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be

25 declared invalid.


26 Section 5: Publication. This ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general

27 circulation in the City of Albany, which said newspaper is designated for that

1 purpose, and it shall be posted in three locations and shall become effective on
2 and after its final passage, adoption and publication.

3 Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days on or
4 after its final passage and adoption.


